Liabilities arising under the Seafarers Rehabilitation and  
Compensation Act 1992 or any state or Territory WCA, including all  
costs and expenses.  
Liability to cargo and property - Rule 2 Sections 14, 15 and 17.

#### **DEDUCTIBLES**

RDC & FFO claims AUD3,000 each incident. (Rule 2 Sections 7 & 8).  
All other claims AUD2,000 each incident.

### DEDUCTIBLES (continued):

When one incident gives rise to claims of a different nature, the aggregate of all claims shall be subject to the highest deductible applicable to any one such claim.

### INFORMATION

Member occasionally (5 or 6 per annum) are engaged in the salvage of sunken vessels, which are predominately private craft. The salvage is always conducted in sheltered waters.

Reference to Association Rules means those rules which apply as at the date of incident giving rise to any claim.

### CLAUSE WORDINGS

#### ADDITIONAL COVER - SPECIALIST OPERATIONS

In accordance with Rule 3, it is hereby agreed to extend cover to include liabilities otherwise excluded under Rule 28.3 A, subject to the following:

ACTIVITIES COVERED: Very occasional salvage

LIMIT OF LIABILITY: AUD 1,000,000 any one accident or occurrence or series of accidents or occurrences arising out of any one event.

DEDUCTIBLE: AUD 5,000 any one accident or occurrence or series of accidents or occurrences arising out of any one event.

Except where specifically mentioned above, cover given under this extension is subject to the limitations and exclusions contained in Parts I, IV and V of the Rules.
